

# ONTARIO'S LONG-TERM CARE HOME RATE REDUCTION PROGRAM

**Residents who make \$25,629\* or less per year, and requesting a "basic" room** (not private, not semi-private) may be eligible for a subsidy to reduce their basic long-term care accommodation through the government of Ontario's Long-Term Care Home Rate Reduction Program. \*2022 income



## HOW TO APPLY

1. Ask your LTC home staff for an application form;
2. Complete the application form;
3. Submit the form to your LTC home between July 1st–Sept 28

## PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

- The program runs from July 1 to June 30 of the following year and the form must be submitted annually.
- For your reduced rate to begin on July 1, you must re-apply between July 1 and September 28.
- If you re-apply and qualify after September 28, your reduced rate will begin to apply for up to 90 days before you submitted your application.
- If you do not re-apply, your long-term care home can charge you the full cost for basic accommodation.
- Most people who receive a rate reduction still pay a portion of their co-payment fees.
- Only the resident, or the resident's POA of Property or Guardian of Property may apply.
- To get help filling out forms, speak to the staff at your LTC home.
